AGENDA PAD

Questions to ask...

- Did your child copy the complete homework assignment for the day?
- Is each subject filled in?

Your child can...

- Ask a classmate or another student on his/her team for the homework assignment.
- Write "no homework" for each class that does not have an assignment to avoid confusion.

CLASS NOTES

Questions to ask...

- Can your child read his/her notes?
- Are your child's notes dated and in the correct section in his/her binder?

Your child can...

- Look at the sample binder in the classroom.
- Look at a peer's binder.
- Go to extra help and ask his/her teacher to help organize.

HOMEWORK

Questions to ask...

- Does your child have his/her notes as a reference while doing the homework?
- Did your child show all work?
- Is your child taking longer than 30 minutes to complete his/her assignment?

Your child can...

- Have a well-lit and quiet homework station with all necessary supplies available.
- Have a regular time every day to do homework.
- Come to extra help to review concepts or start homework.

EXTRA HELP

Questions to ask...

- Is your child having trouble with a concept?
- Does your child need extra practice?

Your child can...

- Attend extra help on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays

ABSENTEES

Questions to ask...

- Did your child get a copy of the notes from when he/she was out?
- Does your child need to go to extra help to reinforce the lesson?

Your child can...

- Call / Email / Text a friend to get the assignment and attempt the homework.
- Have his/her parents call / email guidance for a homework request (teachers have 24 hours to bring work to guidance).
- Email teacher
- Attend extra help
